The Board will consider awarding bids and contracts and/or authorizing purchase orders as recommended in the posted agenda item.

Suggested motion:

I move that the Board authorize purchase orders as recommended in the posted agenda item.

Funding sources/clarification:

The District requested proposals from registered Cypress Fairbanks ISD vendors who were on the Texas DIR contract for Lenovo Desktops. After reviewing proposals, the committee recommended NWN who met all of the quote requirements and provided the best value to the district. NWN would service the desktop under a five year manufacturer's warranty agreement. The District's Service Center has technicians certified to work on Lenovo products for non-warranty repairs. The 2014 Bond (Technology) Referendum allowed for the replacement of aging desktop computers. The District has approximately 250 desktops and 200 point of sale terminals that need to be replaced. It is often difficult to find parts to maintain them. This competitive cooperative quote would allow for the replacement of those devices as well as the purchase for approximately 100 desktops that would be deployed at four new school sites (Bridgeland HS, Hoover ES, Wells ES and Matzke ES). The committee felt that it was in the best interest of the District to award this purchase to NWN. NWN would service the purchased machines under a five year manufacturer's warranty.
