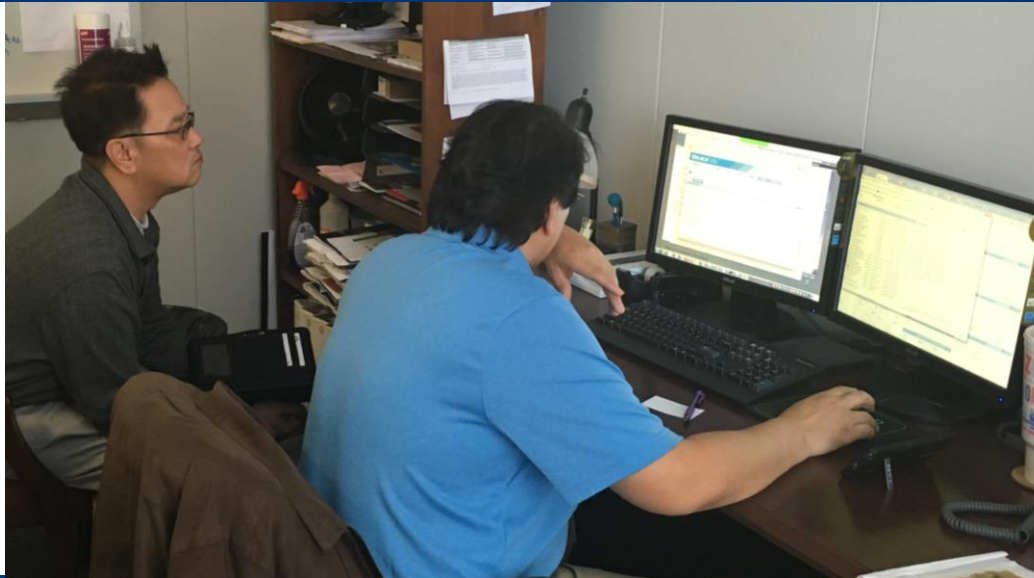




Goal 2

Woodard Elementary School First Campus to Connect to Data Center 4



After several months of hard work, this past week Technology Services brought the first campus online at Data Center 4. Woodard ES was the first campus to utilize network services from Data Center 4. In order to connect to a network, an edge device must receive an Internet Protocol address (IP address). BlueCat Networks provides that service for the CFISD network. Woodard's campus devices connect to the network either wired, with an ethernet cable, or wirelessly with the newly deployed Aruba wireless access system. It was determined that Woodard ES would come online to Data Center 4 in two phases:

- Phase I – Wired on Thursday, January 21, 2016
- Phase II – Wireless on Friday, January 22, 2016
