

Langham Creek High School Network Infrastructure Upgrade is Complete!

The Langham Creek high school network infrastructure upgrade is complete! On the evening of August 5, 2015, Thomas Hollister, the Enterprise Communications Network (ECN) network specialist, coordinated the upgrade, including installing 52 new network switches in 7 network closets, and unpatching/repatching over 2000 network cables. The replacement process started around 3:00 p.m. and it took all evening, till the early morning. Careful timing was considered so that the campus experienced no downtime, as staff waited until after summer school to get started.
