

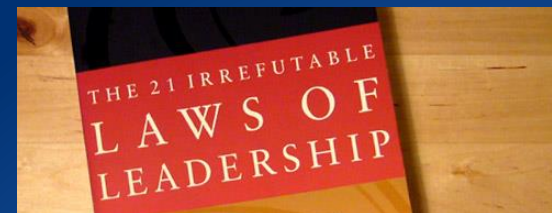

Austen Chang and Daniel discussed Apple application development with Stacy Armstrong of the CyWoods Computer Science department.



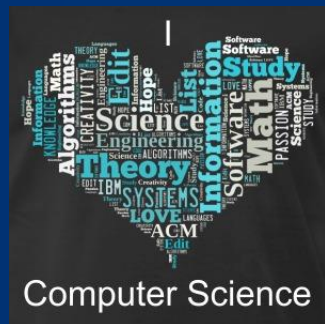
