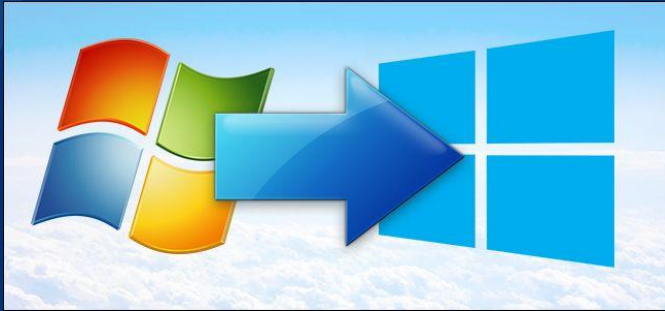

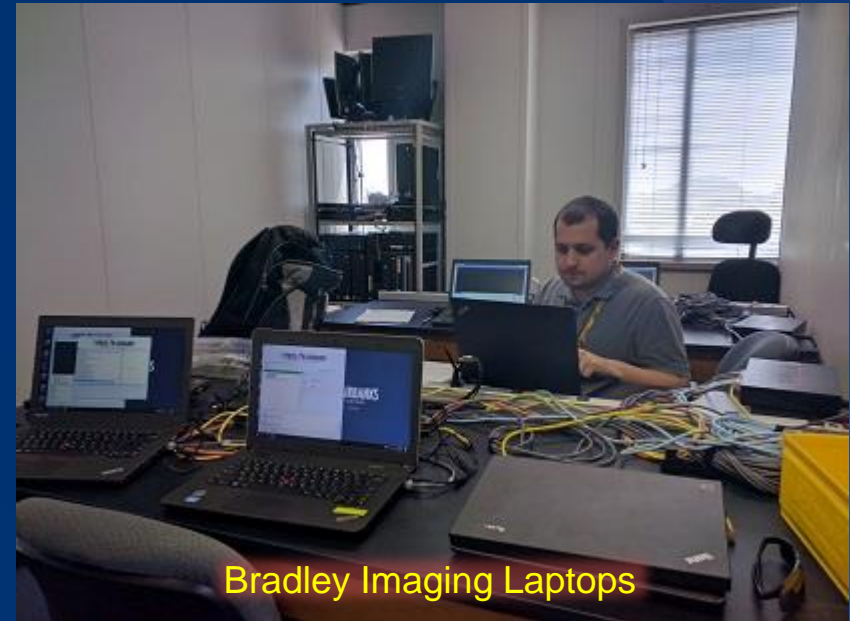
Bradley Assisting DII

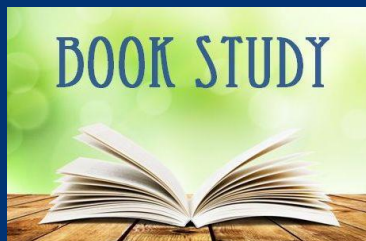
