

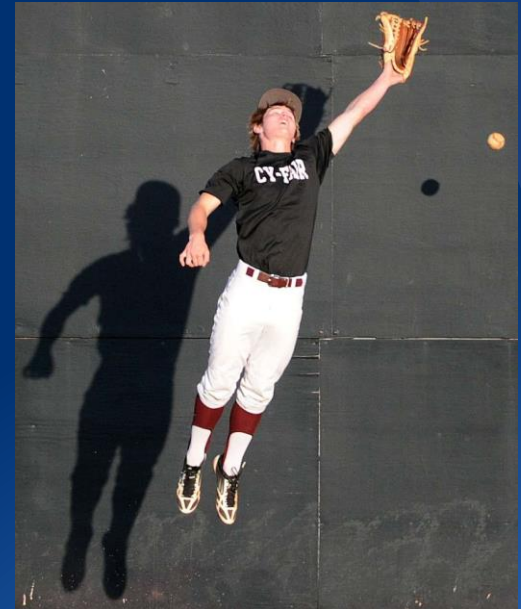


Enterprise Communications Network Operational Highlights

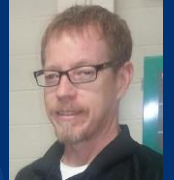

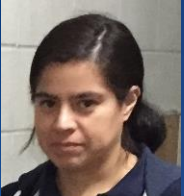

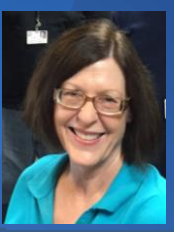
