Frankie Jackson was notified by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) Schools and Library Division (SLD) that we are approved to receive **\$11,440,099** for E-Rate funding reimbursements for 2015-2016. This funding request has been in work since **October 2013!** Katie Hernandez, served as the overall point of contact between CFISD, Education Partners Solution (EPS) and ESC12 E-Rate Works, the district's E-Rate consulting firms. Working with Paula Ross' Network Infrastructure and Communications (NIC) team, these funding reimbursements will offset 2016-2017 budgets as well as refund money back into the 2014 Bond.
