



Network Closet Discussion During the 2017 November Committee of the Whole Meeting

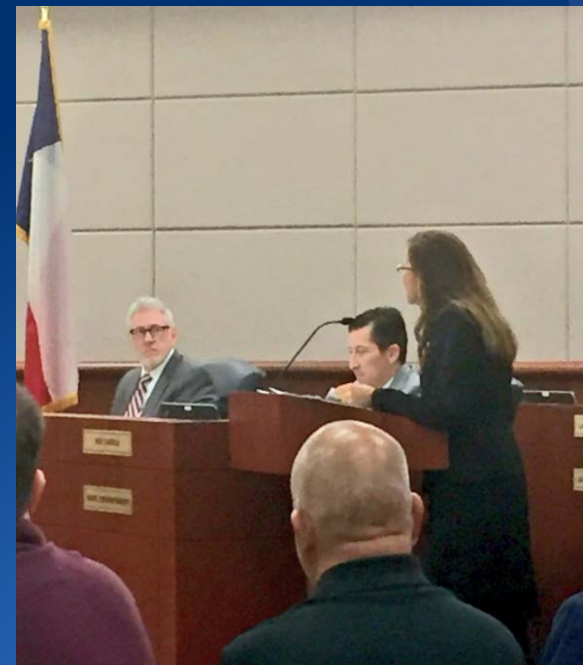
Frankie Jackson responded to Board of Trustee questions at the committee of the whole meeting on **November 9, 2017** about the condition and environment of the district's network closets. Frankie let the Board of Trustees know that assuring the condition of the network closets is a priority. She talked about a process called Proactive Action Report (PAR) that is part of the technician's expectations to conduct regular assessments of the closets. The PAR is looking for closets that are organized, clean, free from storage, with emergency power, and cooled. Frankie will be checking the closets as she visits campuses in the future. She also communicated that the District Improvement Plan (DIP) includes a strategy for addressing network closet environment as shown in the following.

District Improvement Plan Addresses Network Closet Environment

Assure funding is available for the 2014 Bond Technology Infrastructure bond goal 3.2, upgrade electrical power and air conditioning in the campus and facility network distribution closets, some of the older secondary schools and elementary schools and facilities need funding allocations for power and air conditioning upgrades. In some campuses and facilities, there is a need to place all master network distribution closets on emergency power.
