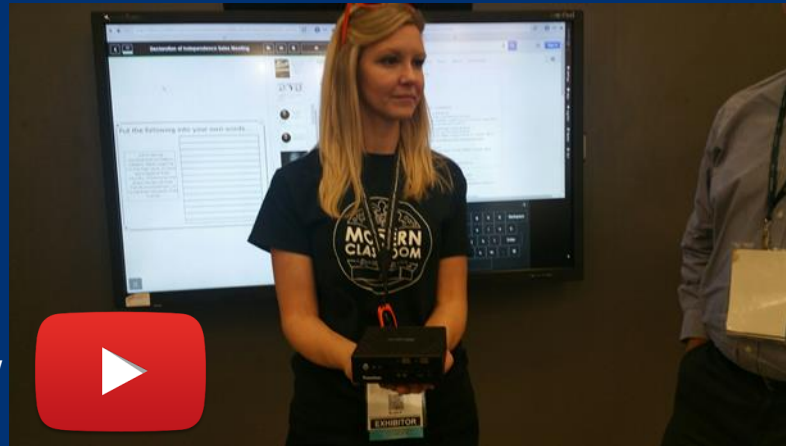




# Texas Computer Education Association (TCEA) Strategic Partner Meetings
