



Meeting with Phonoscope to Discuss the Implementation of RFP 17-01-5080

Frankie Jackson, Paula Ross and Oscar Villar, including Polly Gifford (Education Partners Solution) met with representatives from Phonoscope, including Lee Cook, President and CEO of Phonoscope, on **July 7, 2017**. The team met at the Phonoscope facility.

At the April 2017 Board meeting, the board awarded Phonoscope, Request for Proposal 17-01-5080. Working through the details of how to get the contract started is complex because of the company split between Phonoscope and Pure Speed Lightwave. Phonoscope owns part of CyFair's fiber network, primarily the fiber links to the older parts of CFISD. Pure Speed Lightwave owns other sections of the network, primarily any network additions and/or changes since 2013.

We are working with Phonoscope to build a long-term contract that takes in the new parts of the network that Pure Speed Lightwave owns without having to spend additional funds. Otherwise we may have to structure the contract with both companies. Phonoscope took several actions to analyze fiber routes and cost proposals. A meeting in early August is planned.
