Cybersecurity Framework Overview

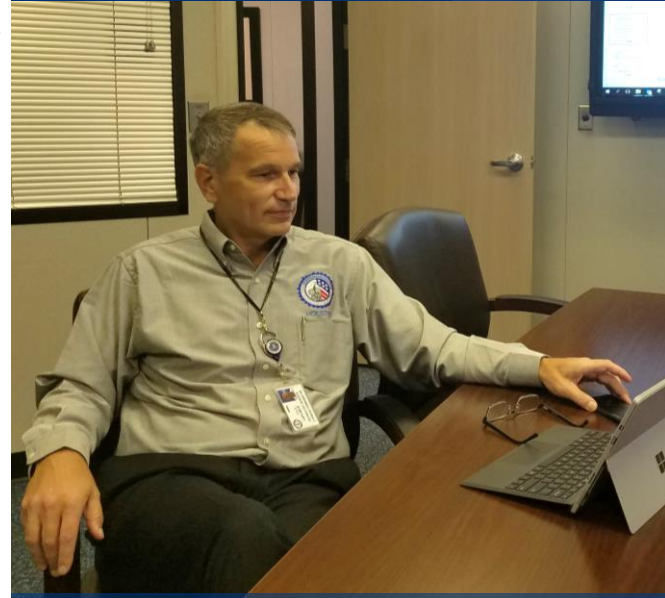
