



# Meeting with Coban to Discuss a New Police Body Camera Recording Solution

The new Chief Mendez's top priority is getting police officers at the campuses setup to use body cameras and have the ability to upload their video footage back to a central server at the police station. The Coban police body camera and recording solution is the solution proposed.

- The current server at the Telge police station may need to be upgraded.
- Plan to test their proposed solution to make sure their system will work in a “multi-location” upload environment. A pilot was suggested before we start a full scale implementation.
- Coban took an action to prepare a proposal with a complete breakdown of everything that is needed. When this is delivered we will review carefully.
