



Upgrades Planned for District Firewalls at Data Center 3 and 4 This Summer

Frankie Jackson, Paula Ross, Greg Rhodes, and Oscar Villar met with Ira Soderberg, our Fortinet Regional Account Manager, on Thursday, **June 9, 2016**, to discuss plans for upgrading the district's firewalls at Data Center 3 and 4 this summer. Three of the firewalls will be configured and upgraded; two firewalls at Data Center 4 to set disaster recovery in place, and one firewall at Data Center 3 to partition network traffic for wired devices.

This work requires major planning because of the DMZs (demilitarized zone sometimes called a perimeter network) that must be initialized. The DMZ is a sub-network that adds an increased layer of security and provides additional filtering for faster speed and increased data protection.
