CFISD_BYOT Wireless Network Connection

District employees and students with a network login can access the Internet using the CFISD_BYOT wireless network on their personal device – cell phone, tablet, laptop computer

On your device select the Wireless Settings, select CFISD_BYOT
Open an Internet browser, when prompted for your network login credentials, enter your network login and password.

Note: If you experience an issue connecting to Apps or your Internet browser, access your default Internet browser and login to the BYOT connection.
