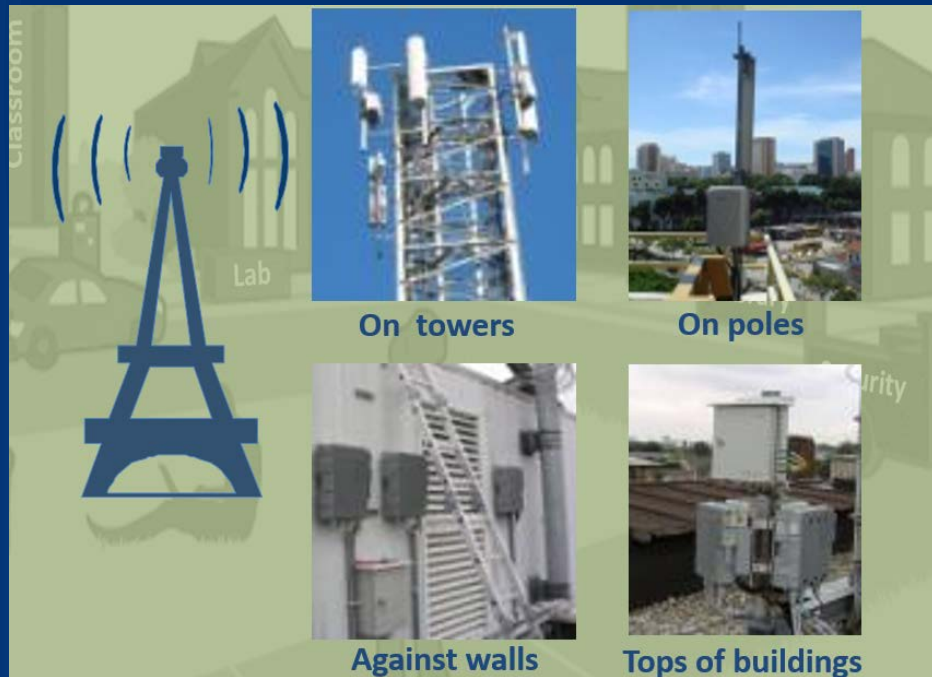




Meeting with M&A Technology to Discuss Connecting Students At Home
