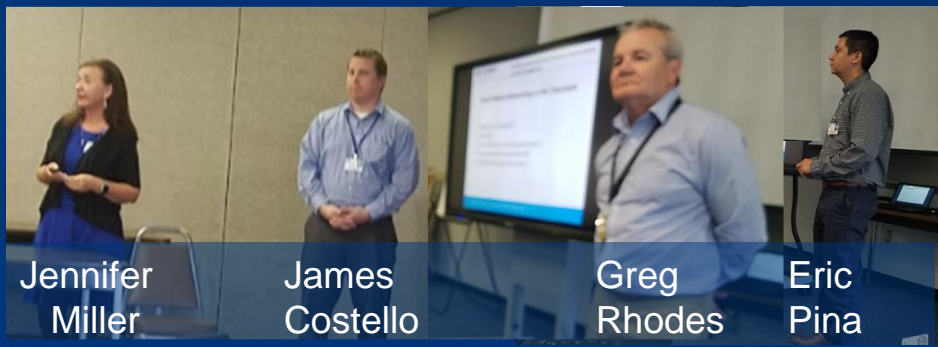




Internet Content Management and Filtering Governance Committee Meeting
