



Training for Librarians to Start the Implementation for Devices for Low Income Families Needing Internet Access at Home

Frankie Jackson participated in a Kajeet training with elementary school librarians on **February 15, 2018**. Kajeet presented trainings all day. Frankie participated in the afternoon session. Jennifer Miller also participated in the training. At the December 2017 Board meeting, the Board of Trustees approved devices for low income families needing Internet devices and access at home. This purchase will provide 2620 devices (60 at each high school, 40 at each middle school and 20 at each elementary school). Each device (Chromebook) and hot spot will have 20 months of unlimited data service.

During the training, Kajeet reviewed the process of checking the devices in and out and shared information about how to use and support the devices. The devices should be ready to distribute to students within the next couple of weeks.
