



Texas Legislative Planning: Analyzing Cost Impacts to Proposed Bills



Frankie Jackson worked with Tom Canby, TASBO Executive Director, on a list of bills that the Texas Legislature is requesting assistance with organizing information about local district cost impacts. Frankie analyzed each of the following bills and worked with Tom to prepare cost impacts and information about the implementation of each bill.

- [HB185](#) Reporting principal turnover information in the performance report of a public school district.
- [HB194](#) Providing for endorsements for public high school students enrolled in special education programs.
- [HB426](#) Relating to parental notification of class sizes at public schools in a district of innovation.
- [SB196](#) Relating to a notification requirement if a public school, including an open-enrollment charter school, does not have a nurse, school counselor, or librarian assigned to the school during all instructional hours.
- [SB673](#) Relating to a notification requirement if a public school campus or open-enrollment charter school does not have a nurse assigned to the campus during all instructional hours.
- [SB 22](#) Authorizing a Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH) program advisory council to design a non-duplicative sequence of progressive achievement involving course study in grades 9 through 12 and postsecondary courses. The courses would lead to high school graduation and to an associate degree, a two-year postsecondary certificate, or industry certification, in addition to participation in work-based training programs.
