



Timeline Set to Get Ready to Implement Senate Bill 507 Special Education Cameras in the Classroom

On Friday, **August 19, 2016**, Frankie Jackson met with Teresa Hull and Roy Sprague, including school administration assistant superintendents to discuss the timeline for implementing the requirements of Senate Bill 507 (Special Education Cameras in the Classroom). Information about Senate Bill 507 is [here](#). A timeline for implementation has been set as shown in the following. The current plan is to use the district's existing security camera system, Exacq. The team is working on a bid specification to assess options and pricing.

TIMELINE

- Between now and September 6, 2016 – Develop Request for Proposal (RFP) Bid Specification
- September 7, 2016 – Last Day to Submit RFPs to Purchasing (to make the October 2016 Board Meeting)
- September 8, 2016 – October 9 – Solicit bid to prospective vendors, evaluation and make recommendation
- October 10, 2016 – Request RFP Approval by the Board of Trustees
- November 10, 2016 – Order and be prepared for installation (starting at Kahla and Kirk)
