We also purchased spare equipment for future requests.

- ✓ August 19, 2016 – Develop Request for Proposal (RFP) Bid Specification
- ✓ August 31, 2016 - Submit RFP to Purchasing
- ✓ September 8, 2016 – October 9 – Solicit bid to prospective venders
- ✓ September 23, 2016 - Evaluation and assess options
- ✓ September 27, 2016 - Make formal recommendation
- ✓ October 10, 2016 – Request RFP Approval by the Board of Trustees
- ✓ October 18, 2016 – Meet with Finance and Police Department to discuss technical details and funding schedule
- ✓ November 15, 2016 – Order and be prepared for installation
