



# Cost Estimates for Satisfying Requirements for SB 507: Cameras in Special Education Classrooms



Frankie Jackson met at the Police Department with Chief Bragg, Juan Cruz, and Dillon Brady on **April 7, 2016** to discuss Senate Bill 507 (installing video cameras in special education classrooms and providing archived data on a 6-month retention cycle). Juan shared his cost estimates, based on our current video management system, Exacqvision. His costs are shown in the following graph, boxed in green. Frankie prepared alternative cost options based on several draft proposals from other video management solution providers (shown boxed in blue). Juan's estimates are based on current bid offerings and are assumed more accurate.

**Next Step:** Dillon has the action to talk to Teresa Hull about setting up a prototype classroom with a complete setup of cameras and server space so we can test and start recording now.
