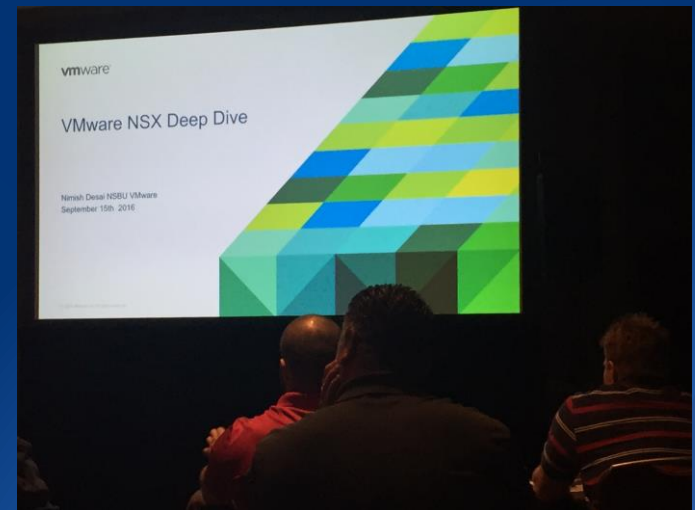




vForum 2016

The conference provided insight into VMware's future direction and added validation to the decisions made in our own virtualization project. The theme was about a "software defined enterprise" with emphasis on mobility, 24X7 innovation, and infrastructure as code. Workspace ONE was introduced where by using the thumbprint on a mobile device, apps could be delivered specific to that user through an encrypted tunnel using NSX. There was a presentation of how hacking networks has evolved more to using social engineering with a "con and exploit" method; other presentations covered the benefits of NSX for security, automation, and application continuity.
