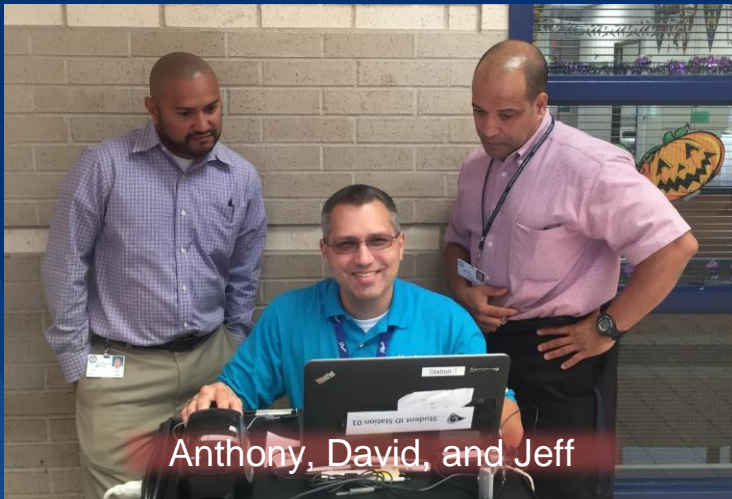


# DII In ACTION

## Yokel display monitors update:

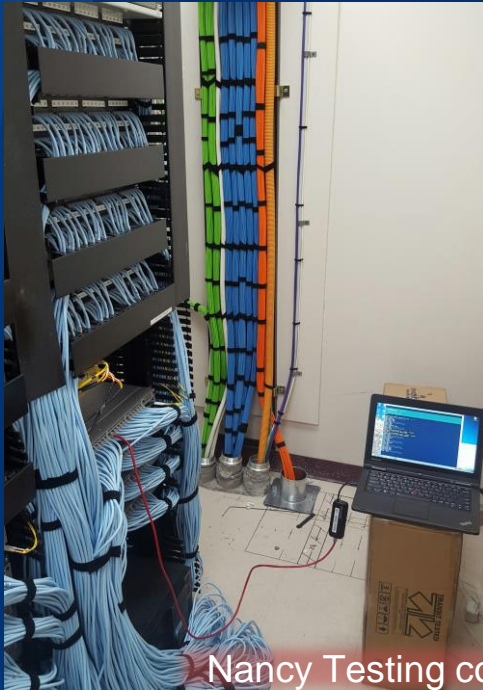
