Netflix Phishing Scam

Currently, there is a massive Netflix phishing scam campaign circulating.

The scam targets subscribers telling them that their account is about to be canceled. The email has the subject line “**Your suspension notification**” and includes a link where the customer is taken to a fake Netflix page which requires their log-in information as well as credit card number. Once the customer clicks the link to update their account information, their personal and credit card information is stolen.

The scam was detected Sunday, November 5, 2017. The fake site includes Netflix’s logo as well as popular Netflix shows like “The Crown” and “House of Cards” to make it seem legitimate.

If you receive an email about Netflix resembling the email shown to the right, delete it. **Do not enter your personal and credit card information.**

Don't fall for this type of scam. If you need to change the settings of subscription services like this, never click on links in any email and just type the name of the site in your browser or use a bookmark that you set.
