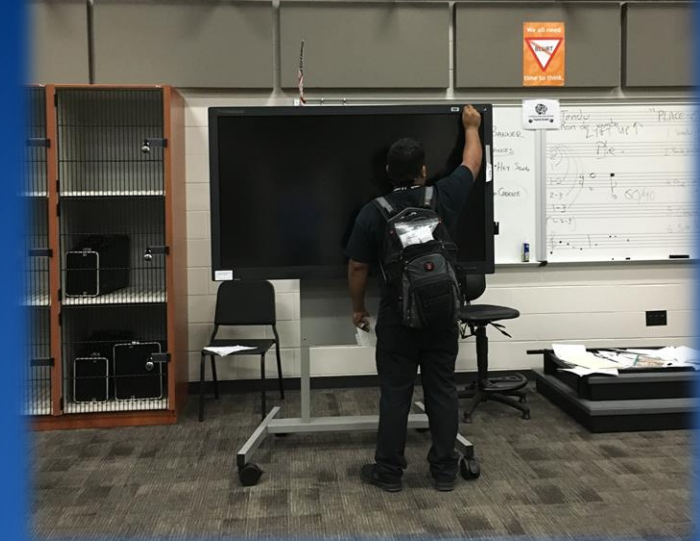




Acquisition Team Announces Customer Service Improvements
