

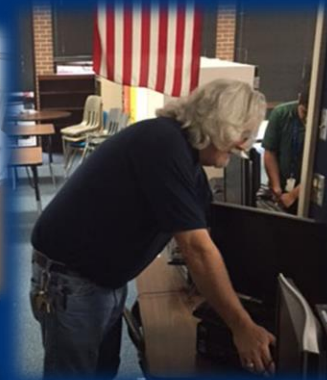


# Technology Service Center Assisting with Assets Relocation

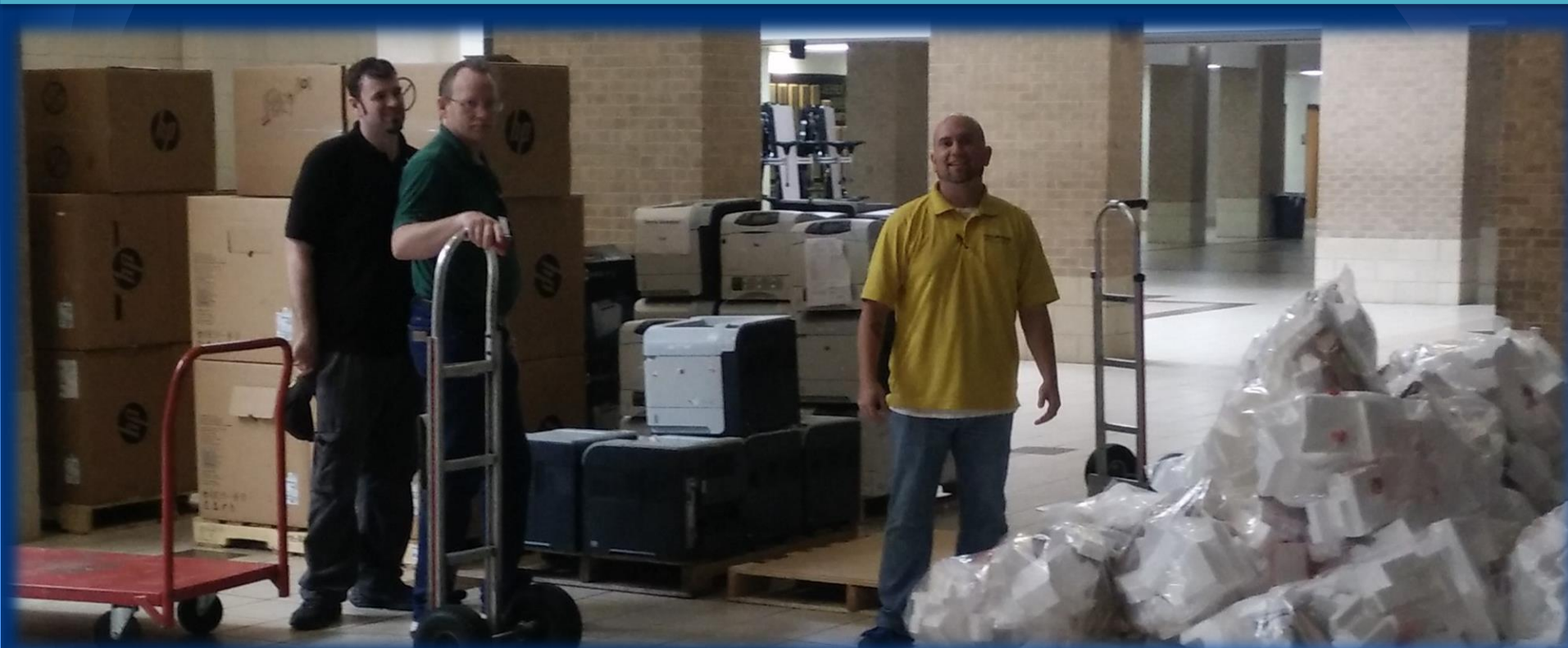
