Official Technology Audit Update

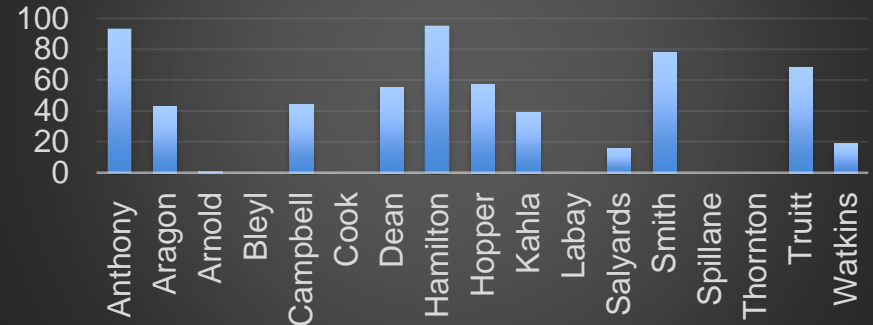
As of November 30, 2015, Technology Services has reached the midpoint of the Official District Technology Asset Audit. Campus Technicians are in the process of completing a room to room scan of their campus prior to December 18, 2015.

Technicians currently use hand-held scanners to complete the scan. At some locations additional Bluetooth devices are also used to speed the process. Overall, the middle school campuses are 34.6% completed with the building scans and the high school campuses are 16.9% completed.

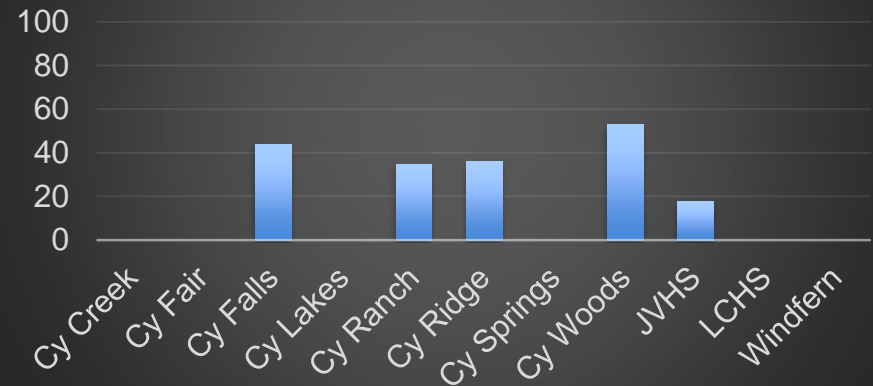
The graphs to the right represent the progress of all secondary campuses as of 8:00am November 30th. A thorough scan involves each technician searching all areas of their campus and scanning every bartagged item. A high school averages 4362 bartagged items while a middle school averages 1751 bartagged items.

In addition, the Asset Team has completed the scanning of elementary campuses in Zone 4. Zone 4 includes Holbrook, Reed, Frazier, Bang, Cook, Gleason, Willbern, Post, Francone, Danish, Yeager, Hancock, Moore, and Matzke. The Asset Team will begin scanning Zone 3 this week.

Completion Percentage as of 11/30/15

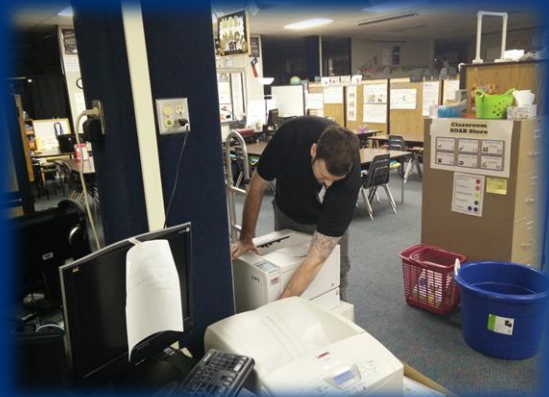




Sustainability Team Continue Printer Pilot at Francone

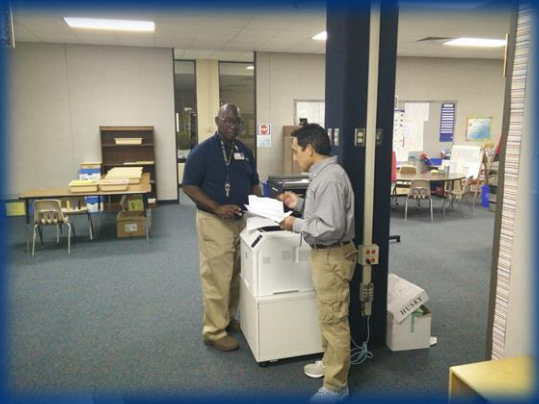


Chris Preston is printing a configuration page.
