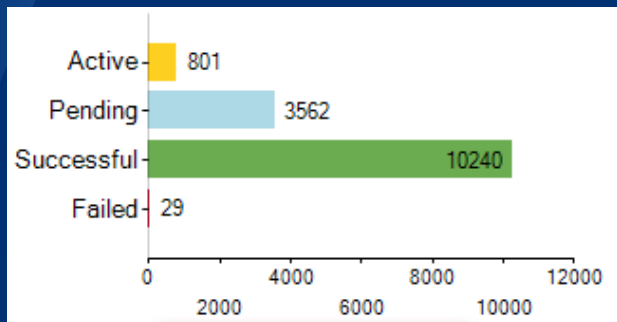

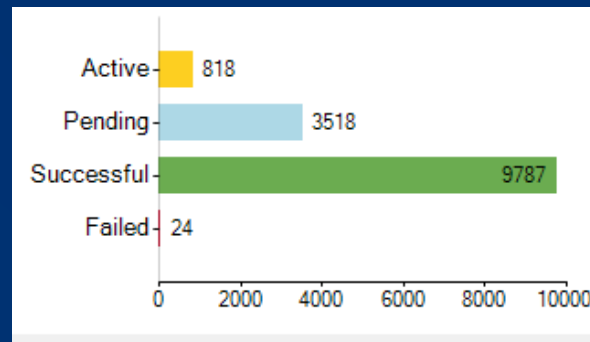

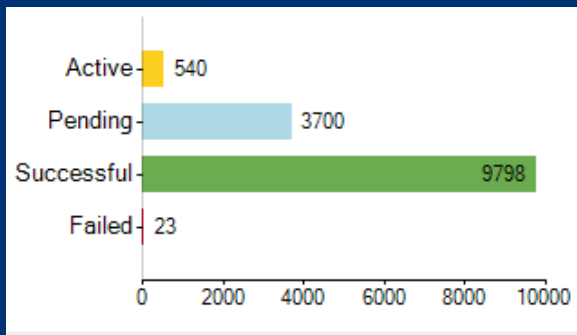
## Kaspersky Uninstall Project



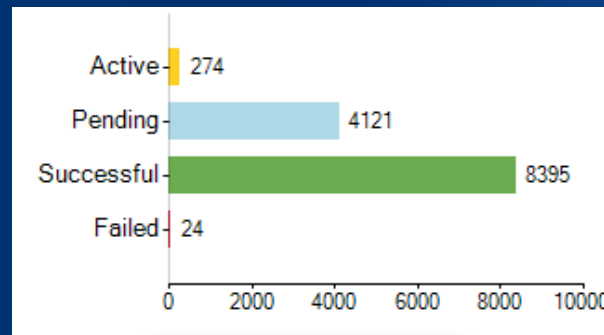
Core ES01
