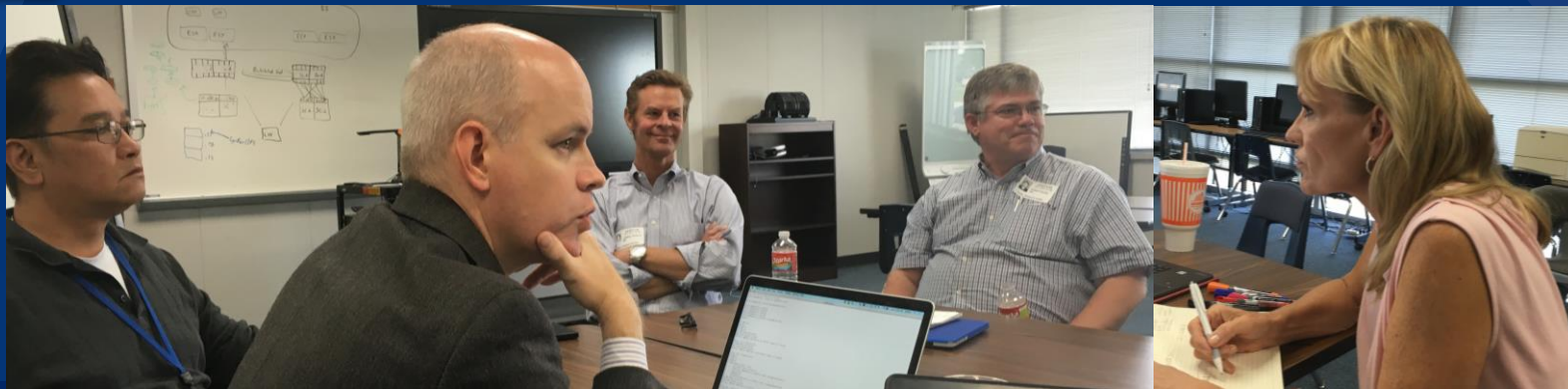

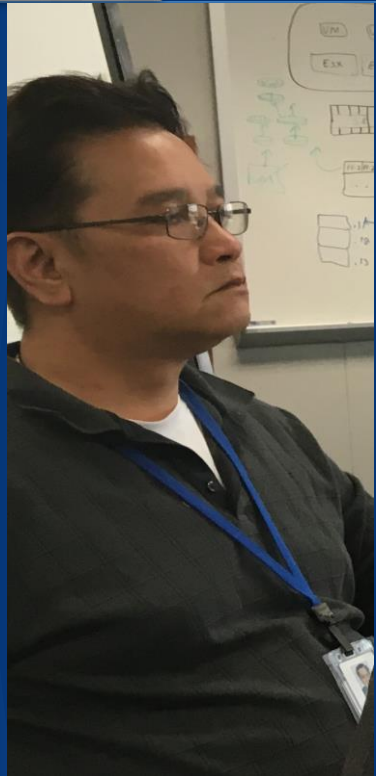

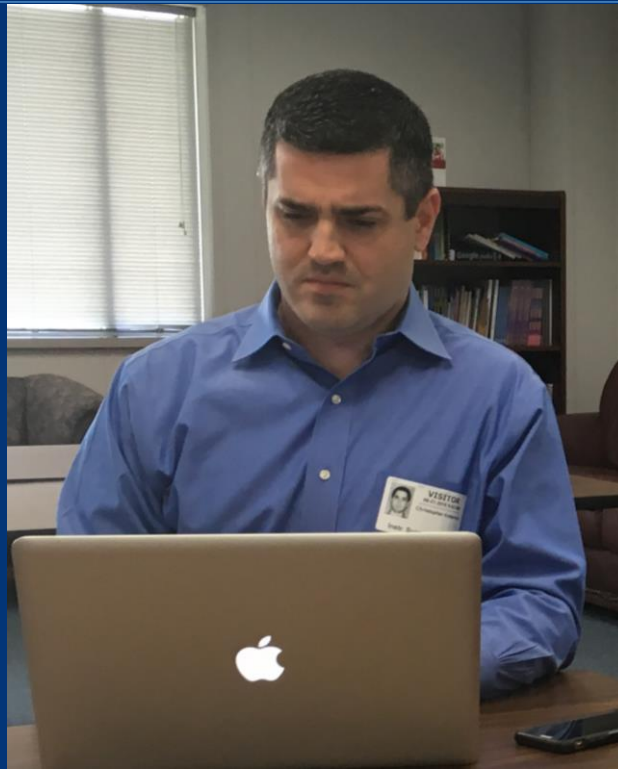

Eleven Fortinet Firewalls Receive A Minimum of Two Firmware Upgrades

The first order of business to be dealt with before the new DMZ can be brought online is to upgrade the firmware on all Fortinet firewalls. On **June 22, 2016**, **Andrew Tran** worked with Chris Anderson, M&S Technologies, to complete this task. Beginning at 4:00pm Wednesday evening, all firewalls were updated from firmware version 5.2.3, to version 5.2.5, then to version 5.2.7. All firewalls were updated, with the exception of a single BYOT firewall. After troubleshooting the situation, it was determined that the BYOT firewall needed to be returned to Fortinet and a replacement device was ordered.
