



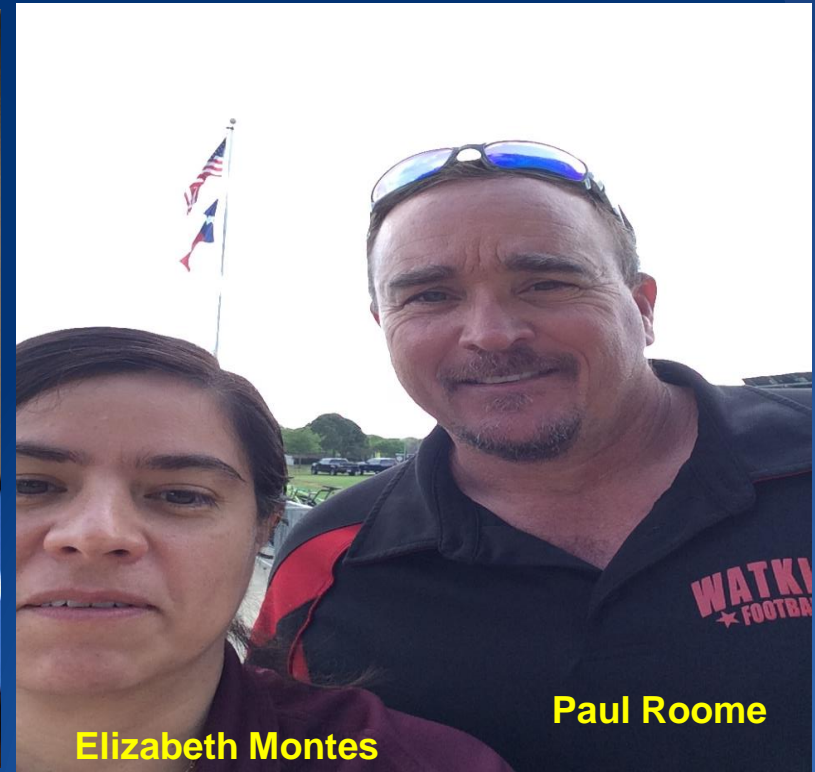
Enterprise Infrastructure Communication Operational Highlights

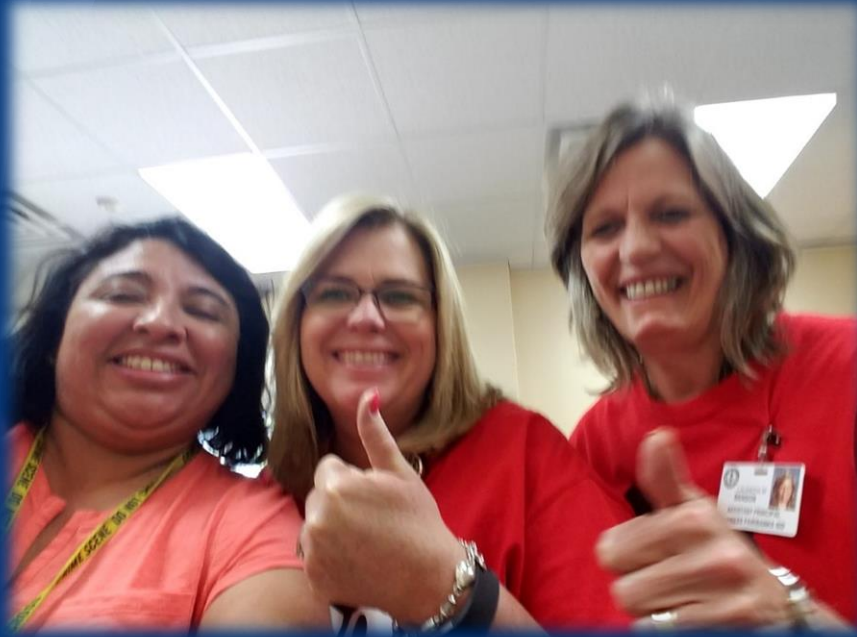
