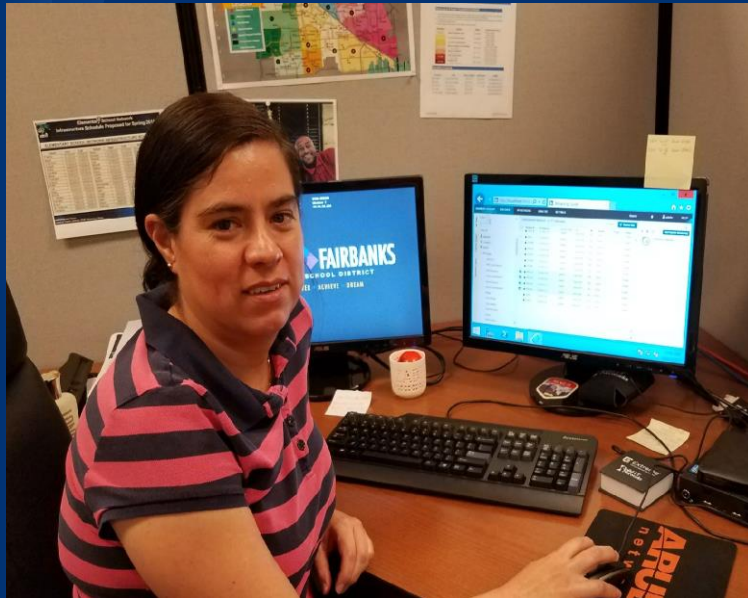




# Enterprise Communication Networks Organizational Announcement
