TASBO selected about 30 members to visit Texas legislative offices to provide information about how TASBO can serve as a neutral resource.



Members divided into 3-4 person teams, each supporting their areas of expertise. The following list are the technology related bills that Frankie was asked to support. Frankie was honored to serve TASBO in this capacity and represent CFISD.

- [HB185](#) Reporting principal turnover information in the performance report of a public school district.
- [HB194](#) Providing for endorsements for public high school students enrolled in special education programs.
- [HB426](#) Relating to parental notification of class sizes at public schools in a district of innovation.
- [SB196](#) Relating to a notification requirement if a public school, including an open-enrollment charter school, does not have a nurse, school counselor, or librarian assigned to the school during all instructional hours.
- [SB673](#) Relating to a notification requirement if a public school campus or open-enrollment charter school does not have a nurse assigned to the campus during all instructional hours.
- [SB 22](#) Authorizing a Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH) program advisory council to design a non-duplicative sequence of progressive achievement involving course study in grades 9 through 12 and postsecondary courses.
- [SB 200](#) – transmit electronic copies of each school district's adopted budget and any school district financial reports filed with and reviewed by the agency comptroller with information to operate and update the Political Subdivision Public Information Warehouse under Section 403.0243, Government Code.
