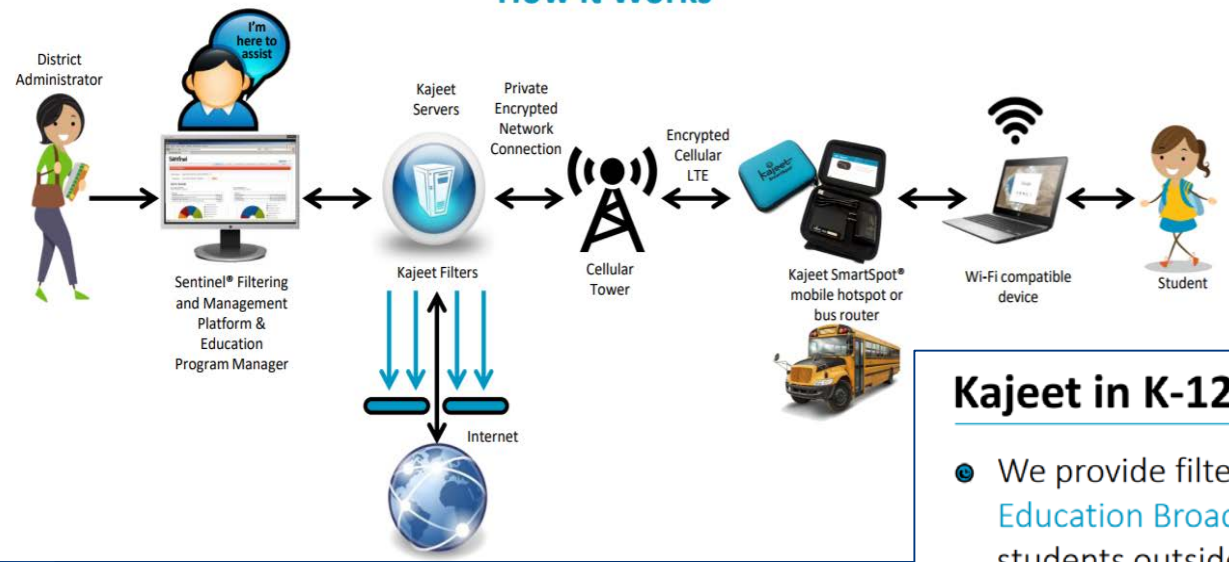




Board Approval for Devices for Low Income Families Needing Internet Access at Home

At the **December 11, 2017** Board of Trustee meeting, the Board of Trustees approved devices for low income families needing Internet devices and access at home. This purchase will provide 2620 devices (60 at each high school, 40 at each middle school and 20 at each elementary school). Each device (Chromebook) and hot spot will have 20 months of unlimited data service. Students will be able to check out these devices from the library to use at school and at home. These devices will allow the district to bridge the gap for low income students whose families may not be able to provide internet service or a device that is capable of internet service.
