

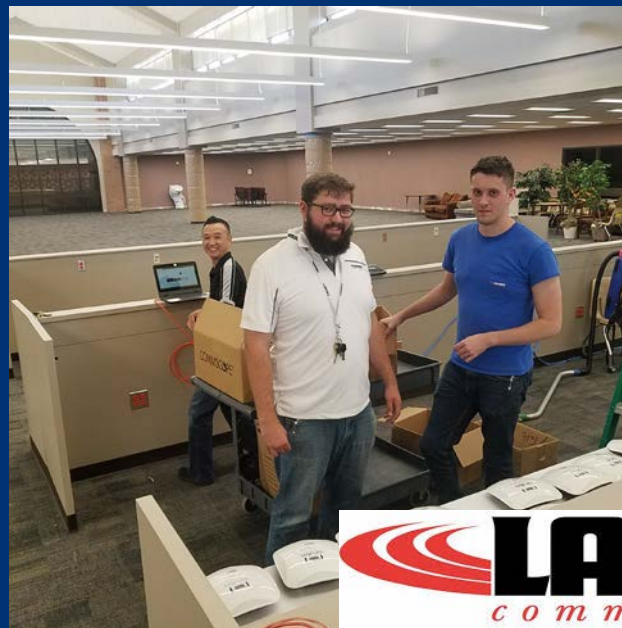
# Wireless Access Points Being Reinstalled After Massive Renovations at CyFalls This Summer
