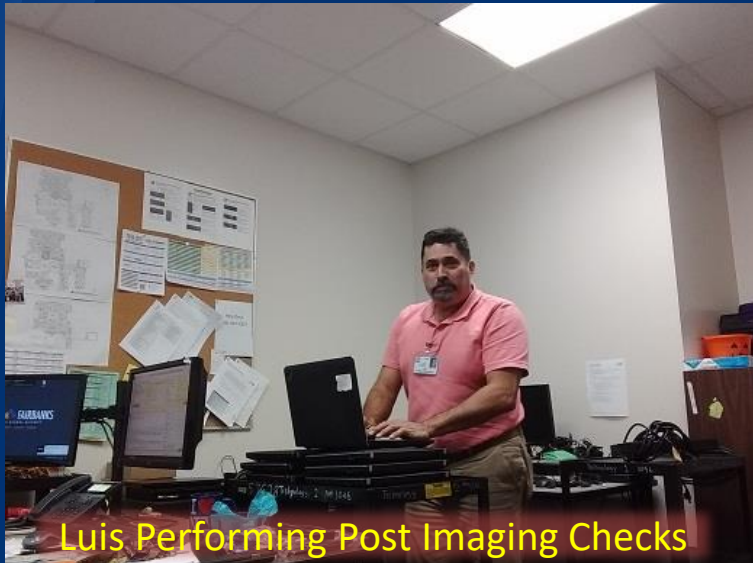

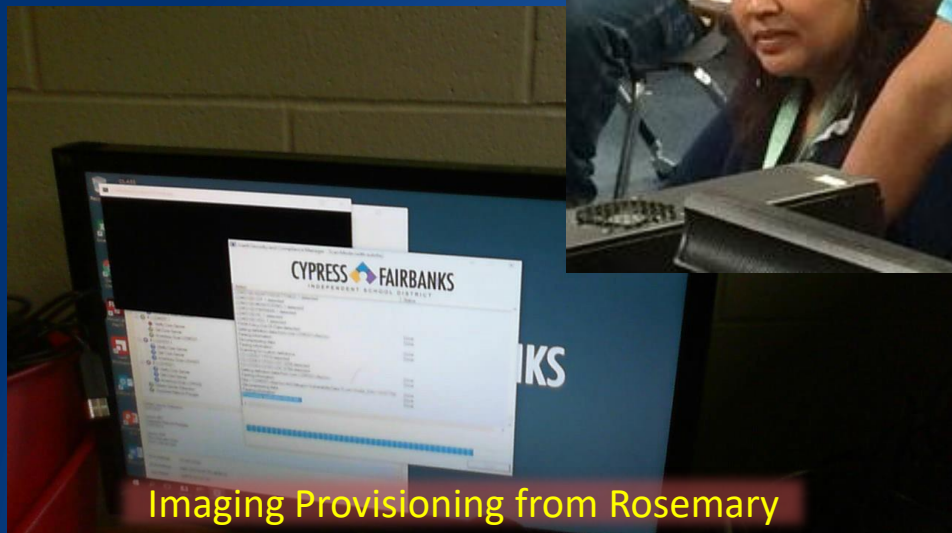
Imaging at Truitt and Jersey Village
